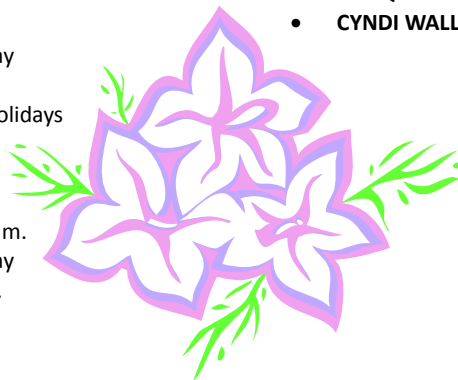

Greens:

In July and August there is not much going on regarding golf course special projects since these are the two hottest months of the year; the maintenance crew keeps themselves busy mowing grass, pruning trees and bushes, as well as hand watering hot spots on greens and fairways; to be able to maintain the Bermuda grass looking lush green under heat pressure takes a lot of hard work and commitment and the maintenance staff members have it all.

Despite the high humidity and triple digit temperatures, the golf course has held it's great conditions throughout the first stage of the summer months, so if you don't mind the hot weather come out and enjoy the great golf course conditions before aerification begins again in September.

As a friendly reminder, please repair ball marks on the greens, maintain a distance of (30) thirty feet away from the greens, use cart paths when around the greens and tees, and do not park on the mounds; let's keep Rio Bravo as beautiful as we can.

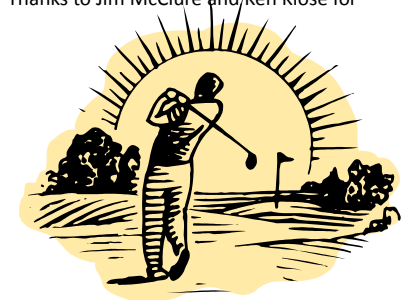

7-21-11

ABSENT BOARD MEMBERS: Dennis Lewis, Pat Embree

Meeting called to order by President Reedy at 4:30 p.m. Previous minutes were not available for approval.

CLUB MANAGEMENT – Trini Hernandez – July 4th event was very successful, although not profitable, for Club. It was mostly a break even affair. A big thank you was extended to all those volunteers who put a lot of work and time into making it a great event. Trini indicated HOA's are already trying to raise money so we can continue to sponsor this event. New computer system is in place but staff need some more time to make it as effective as it should be. Club does have good support system when questions arise.

COURSE MAINTENANCE – Trini Hernandez – No particular projects are going on at this time. Lakes have been sprayed & are looking better. Ladies' tee boxes on #7 & #13 have been extended. Wet areas on course have been noted & are due to water leaks and/or homeowner runoffs. Weeds right on #7 fairway & left of #11 are of concern & have been brought to fire department's attention. These areas are privately owned & not the responsibility of Club. Hard pan area on left side of fairway, #4, about 160 yards out needs to be marked off or planted. Club is considering a practice area behind tee boxes on #5 so players can keep busy if they have to wait.

PRO SHOP – Jim Kiger – Five new members joined this last month. There was a good turnout for Flag Day & Fathers' Day tournaments. Jr. Golf Clinic on 6/21 went well. Ladies' Club was again in semi-finals for team play but lost. South Valley team play begins in August. Upcoming events
